SUBJECT: Senate Bill 1022 (Adult Local Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Financing Program), Tulare County's Request for Extension of Scope Change: **Requesting Approval**

Summary

This agenda item requests the Board of State and Community Corrections' (BSCC) approval of Tulare County's request for a change in scope for the Tulare County Sequoia Field Program Facility.

Background

At the March 13, 2014 BSCC meeting, (Agenda item L, Attachment F-1), the BSCC approved a partial conditional award of \$33,352,000.

At the April 9, 2015 BSCC meeting (Agenda item C, Attachment F-2) the BSCC approved Tulare County's request to extend its time to accept its partial award from March 31, 2015 until September 17, 2015 to allow county staff "to fully evaluate the optimum method of reducing the scope while preserving the most critical elements of the future facility."

The BSCC received a letter dated July 31, 2015 from Tulare County formally accepting the BSCC conditional partial award and now requests approval of the submitted reduced scope of work (Attachment F-3) commensurate with the proposed partial award of \$33,352,000. The Sequoia Field Program Facility will have three major components: Jail, day reporting center and vocational training center. The jail includes 192 beds, housing units with medical and mental health suites, adjacent program rooms, outdoor recreation, a laundry and a kitchen. The vocational center has multiple shop spaces for hands-on instruction.

Recommendation/Action Needed

Staff recommends the Board approve Tulare County's scope change, in connection with the Sequoia Field Program Facility, Senate Bill 1022 Jail Construction Financing Program project.
