After much deliberation and discussion with our team it is necessary to advise the Board of State and Community Corrections that Glenn County is unable to accept our grant award and take part in the Justice Assistance Grant. No funding has been expended from our award.


We accepted participation in this program with the best of intentions, however, our current staffing precludes us from carrying out the requirements of the grant. Even though we initiated an active recruitment before we entered into the program we have yet to fill our allocations. As you may well be aware, this is a common problem in law enforcement at this time.

Our goal was to assign one Detective to the program. Unfortunately we have been completely overwhelmed with high level felony investigations which have prevented us from having an officer devoted to the program. In addition, the reporting requirements are so stringent that once again we find that we do not have adequate staff to track, record, and report grant activities.

We appreciate your assistance and understanding in our attempts to put together our program. However, we feel that other agencies that do have a viable program should have the opportunity to make use of the funding awarded to us. Therefore we are requesting that the monies awarded to Glenn County be disencumbered and awarded to another agency.

We look forward to the time when our agency has the capacity to once again apply for and be awarded a JAG grant. Again, thank you for your understanding and assistance.
