  - Consider how to align different reporting requirements—including possible single annual county report for both programs
  - Consider how BSCC annual reports could or should be reconfigured in a manner consistent with changes recommended in county reporting requirements
  - Consider what supported revisions can be done internally at BSCC without legislative revision
