SUBJECT: **AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING FOR RESIDENTIAL SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT (RSAT) FOR STATE PRISONERS PROGRAM**

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is pleased to announce the availability of approximately \$892,576 in federal RSAT funds to support California's efforts in providing resources to local county level adult detention facilities for in-custody treatment services that includes a follow-up aftercare component. The RSAT Program is made available by the Bureau of Justice Assistance.

The funding for this project will enhance the capability of units of local government to provide substance abuse treatment for incarcerated inmates in local county jails; prepare offenders for their reintegration into the communities from which they came by incorporating reentry planning activities into treatment programs; and assist offenders and their communities through the reentry process by delivering community-based treatment and other broad-based aftercare services.

Eligible adult detention facilities will be allowed to request up to a maximum of \$223,144 for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 with the possibility of an additional two years of funding to qualified applicants.
