It would require the BSCC to, upon appropriation*, award funding for a grant program to four or more county superior courts or county probation departments to create demonstration projects to reduce the recidivism of high-risk misdemeanor probationers using risk assessments at sentencing and formal probation. BSCC would be required to develop county reporting requirements and submit a final report to the Legislature and county criminal justice officials. This bill establishes a sunset date of January 1, 2021.  * There has been no appropriation for this bill.	Upon appropriation, the BSCC is required to administer the grant program, develop reporting requirements and submit a final report.	Chaptered.

Upon appropriation*, BSCC would be required to contract with an academic institution, public policy center, or other research entity for an independent evaluation on the impact this legislation has, specifically looking at the impact by race, ethnicity, gender, and income level.  * There has been no appropriation for this bill.	Upon appropriation, the BSCC is required to contract for an independent evaluation to be completed no later than January 1, 2024.	Chaptered.

This bill extends the operative date of the authorization to establish a pilot program in those counties to January 1, 2022. The bill also expands the scope of the program to include the County of Ventura. This bill also provides a due date for BSCC to submit a comprehensive report to the Assembly and Senate Committees on Public Safety of December 31. 2020.	Adds an additional county and a due date for the BSCC to submit a Legislative Report no later than December 31, 2020.	Chaptered.
