SUBJECT: AVAILABLILITY OF FUNDING FOR THE ADULT REENTRY GRANT -COHORT 4

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is announcing the release of the Adult Reentry Grant Program Request for Proposals (RFP). This RFP makes \$114,000,000 available for a grant period that covers July 1, 2025, through December 31, 2028.

The Adult Reentry Grant program was established in the Budget Act of 2018 (Senate Bill 840, Chapter 29, Statutes of 2018) to provide funding for community-based organizations to deliver reentry services for people formerly incarcerated in state prison.

Eligible applicants are <u>Community-Based Organizations</u> located in the State of California that have been determined by the IRS to have 501(c)(3) status.

Proposals must be received by the BSCC by **5:00 p.m. on March 3, 2025**. A copy of the RFP is attached and is available on the BSCC <u>website</u>.

A virtual Grant Information Session will be held via Zoom on December 17, 2024, at 1:30 P.M. A link to the Information Session is provided within the RFP and will be posted on the BSCC website.
