Scope of Position:

Under the general directions of the Chief Information Officer (CIO), an Information Technology Supervisor II, the Information Technology Specialist II serves as the Lead for the System Engineering team. The position encompasses a full range of responsibilities in support of the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) staff. The Information Technology Specialist II has is responsible for the design, maintenance and operation of agency, systems and networks (both local and cloud based). The Information Technology Specialist II provides guidance, direction and support to IT staff in their network and systems administration efforts.

Duties and Responsibilities:

(Candidates must perform the following functions with or without reasonable accommodations.)

- **Systems Engineering** - Lead for Systems Engineering. Overall responsibility for the installation, deployment, configuration, administration and support of all BSCC servers, networking devices, and Microsoft Azure environment. Maintains systems security, ensuring hardware and software applications are patched and up to date. Manage and document backup systems and disaster recovery processes and operations. Troubleshoot, monitor and optimize system performance. Leads and provides technical consultation on complex Information Technology (IT) solutions, data architecture reviews, short-term and long-term tactical strategic IT plans. Liaisons with California Department of Technology to coordinate system updates and maintenance.
- **Project Management** - The incumbent accepts leadership responsibility for multiple tasks/projects, applies sound project management principles, and follows standards and guidelines in leading information technology projects as required.
