Mobile Probation Service Centers Grant Program

- *Established by the Budget Act of 2022 (Assembly Bill 178).
- Authorized \$20,000,000 for a competitive grant program open only to County Probation Departments.
- To develop programs that assist probationers, particularly those who are homeless and struggling to meet probation requirements.
- Allows the purchase of vehicles, equipment, telecommunications and other technology needed to operate mobile service centers.
