SUBJECT: Senate Bill 1022 (Adult Local Criminal Justice Facilities Construction

Financing Program) San Joaquin County Scope Change:

Requesting Approval.

Summary

This agenda item requests the Board's approval of San Joaquin County's request to receive reverted SB 1022 funds and approve a project scope change to its Adult Local Criminal Justice Facilities (ALCJF) project.

Background

On June 27, 2012, Senate Bill 1022 (Chapter 42, Statutes of 2012) became law, authorizing lease revenue bond authority for the construction of adult local criminal justice facilities. The current funding authority is \$509,060,000. The Board fully allocated the initial funding at its January 16, 2014 meeting by making conditional awards to 14 counties. On February 4, 2016, following the relinquishment of a conditional award by Santa Barbara County, San Joaquin County was awarded a conditional partial award of \$32,328,000, out of the requested \$40,000,000. (Attachment G-1)

There is currently \$806,000 of unallocated funds in the large-county category that never were awarded and an additional \$3,377,286 of unallocated funds in the medium-county category that are the result of a project savings reversion from Stanislaus County. In total there is \$4,183,286 available to be allocated in SB 1022.

It has been past practice of this Board to allow funds reverted by a county to be awarded to the next county in ranked order within the same county population category, and then to another population category if there are no additional counties in the original category

On August 28, 2019 the BSCC received a letter from San Joaquin requesting the reverted funds and requesting approval of a project scope change (Attachment G-2). The primary purpose of the scope change would be to add a new 12-bed mental health wing to the existing project.

Recommendation/Action Needed

Staff recommends that the Board approve the additional award amount of \$4,183,286
of remaining unallocated funds in the large-and medium-county categories to San
Joaquin County.

2. Staff also recommends the Board approve San Joaquin County's request for a scope change of its Adult Local Criminal Justice Facilities project.
