Program): San Mateo County Relinquishment/Sacramento County Award:

Requesting Approval.

Summary

San Mateo County has formally relinquished its Senate Bill (SB) 1022 Adult Local Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Financing Program funding award of \$24,374,000. This agenda item requests that the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC)acknowledge and accept this relinquishment and approve formal notification to Sacramento County to augment to a full award of \$80,000,000 the partial award of \$56,432,000 the County received on January 16, 2014 (Attachment K-1).Background

Background

The currently authorized SB 1022lease revenue bond funding authority is \$500,000,000. This amount has been fully allocated with conditional awards to 15 counties.

At the January 16, 2014 BSCC Board meeting San Mateo County was granted a conditional award of \$24,374,000, and Sacramento was awarded a conditional partial award of \$56,432,000 of its proposed application of \$80,000,000 (Attachment K-1).

On May 6, 2015 the County of San Mateo provided formal notice declining the conditional award (Attachment K-2).

Upon San Mateo's decline of its award, Sacramento is the next in rank order in the Large County Set-aside category of counties. It has been past practice of this Board since the AB 900 programs to allow reverted funds by a county to be awarded to the next county in ranked order within the same category.

Recommendation/Action Needed

- Staff recommends the Board acknowledge that San Mateo County has declined its SB 1022Adult Local Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Financing Program funding award.
- 2. Staff recommends making Sacramento County's partial award a full award (\$56,432,000 to \$80,000,000) and requests Board approval to formally present this full award proposal to the county for its approval.
