MIRA LOMA WOMEN'S DETENTION CENTER REQUEST FOR SCOPE REVISION SPECS. 7266 PROJECT ID 00001114; PROJECT P6971900

On August 17, 2015, the State Public Works Board established the Mira Loma Women's Detention Center (MLWDC) project. Since that time, the County has worked to develop the scoping documents for the eventual design-build delivery of the project. During the course of developing the scoping documents, changes were made to the program, including square footage reductions and additions, resulting in the enclosed space list changes. The combined total of the changes amounts to a 23,530 square foot reduction and is within eight percent of the original space list.

The main additions to the space list consist of a new support services warehouse for medical storage, laundry storage, general warehouse, maintenance, and commissary, and a new entry building that will serve as the main access point for visitors to the facility. Also, wash rooms and showers are added to Buildings 4, 5, and 6 in order to repurpose these buildings to accommodate the transitional housing program.

Due to the repurposing of existing Buildings 4, 5, and 6 to transition housing, one of the previously proposed new construction transitional housing building was deleted. The day space rooms in the twinned dormitory barracks were also reduced in size while still meeting code requirements. A summary of these changes are shown in the enclosed space list.

Overall, the County believes these revisions to the space list provide a more efficient use of existing buildings on site, better accommodate the proposed operation of the facility and provides much needed public interface program space. Thus, the County respectfully requests approval of these scope revisions and looks forward to continuing to the next project milestone of performance criteria approval.
