LOCAL DEFINITIONS

Program Completion

 Identify a milestone to serve as an indicator for program completion.

Recidivism

- BSCC definition:
 - conviction of a new felony or misdemeanor committed within three years of release from custody or committed within three years of placement on supervision for a previous criminal conviction (CA Penal Code § 6046.1(d)).
 - "Committed" refers to the date of the offense, not the date of conviction.



OBTAINING RECIDIVISM DATA

- Can be challenging
- Possible sources
 - Local law enforcement agencies
 - County court system
 - California Dept. of Justice
- Start planning now


LOCAL EVALUATION PLAN

 - Process Evaluation Method and Design

LOGIC MODEL

A visual representation of the project depicting the logical relationships between the inputs/resources, activities, outputs, and outcomes/impacts of a project.

 - Outcome Evaluation Method, Design, Results and Discussion
 - Conclusions and Recommendations
 - Current Logic Model
 - Grantee Highlights
