Involuntary Home Detention (Penal Code Section 1203.017)

In late 2007, Penal Code Section 1203.017 was added to allow for the Involuntary Home Detention (IHD) of criminal offenders. Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1203.017(h) 1, the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC), formerly Corrections Standards Authority, is required to collect data relevant to IHD from each jurisdiction participating in, and responsible for, IHD placement. The BSCC will be collecting data for each calendar year beginning January 1, 2008.

The law requires that correctional administrators, which include sheriffs, probation officers, or directors of departments of corrections, provide data relative to persons placed on IHD.
