Figure 1. Statewide Average Daily Population of County Jails for 2006 through 2021 1






Figure 2. Statewide County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2006 through 2021 1





Figure 4. Statewide County Jail Population by Gender as a Percent of ADP for 2006 through 2021 1





Figure 5. Alameda County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 2021¹



Figure 12. Butte County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 13. Butte County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211











Figure 16. Calaveras County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 18. Colusa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 19. Colusa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 21. Contra Costa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 22. Contra Costa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 24. Del Norte County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹





Figure 25. Del Norte County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹





Figure 27. El Dorado County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 28. El Dorado County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211






Figure 29. Fresno County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211






Figure 32. Glenn County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211






Figure 35. Humboldt County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211






Figure 38. Imperial County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211






Figure 41. Inyo County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211





Figure 45. Kern County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 46. Kern County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 48. Kings County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 49. Kings County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹





Figure 51. Lake County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 52. Lake County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211




Figure 53. Lassen County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211





Figure 57. Los Angeles County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 58. Los Angeles County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 60. Madera County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 61. Madera County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 63. Marin County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 64. Marin County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹





Figure 66. Mariposa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 67. Mariposa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹




Figure 68. Mendocino County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211






Figure 71. Merced County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20201






Figure 74. Modoc County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20201






Figure 77. Mono County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211





Figure 81. Monterey County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 82. Monterey County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹





Figure 84. Napa County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 85. Napa County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹










Figure 88. Nevada County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211






Figure 89. Orange County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211





Figure 93. Placer County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 94. Placer County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211











Figure 97. Plumas County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 99. Riverside County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 100. Riverside County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 102. Sacramento County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 103. Sacramento County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 105. San Benito County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 106. San Benito County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 108. San Bernardino County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 109. San Bernardino County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 111. San Diego County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 112. San Diego County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211




Figure 113. San Diego Work Furlough Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211



Figure 116. San Francisco County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20201





Figure 117. San Francisco County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2019



Figure 119. San Joaquin County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 120. San Joaquin County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 122. San Luis Obispo County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 123. San Luis Obispo County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 125. San Mateo County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 126. San Mateo County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹





Figure 128. Santa Barbara County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹





Figure 129. Santa Barbara County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211




Figure 130. Santa Clara County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211





Figure 134. Santa Cruz County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 135. Santa Cruz County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 137. Shasta County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 138. Shasta County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211




Figure 139. Siskiyou County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211





Figure 143. Solano County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 144. Solano County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 146. Sonoma County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 147. Sonoma County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 149. Stanislaus County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 150. Stanislaus County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211




Figure 151. Sutter County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211






Figure 154. Tehama County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211









Figure 160. Tulare County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 161. Tulare County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 163. Tuolumne County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 164. Tuolumne County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211




Figure 165. Ventura County Average Daily Jail Population for 2011 through 20211





Figure 169. Yolo County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 170. Yolo County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 172. Yuba County Jail Population by Sentenced and Non-Sentenced as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 20211





Figure 173. Yuba County Jail Population by Offense Type as a Percent of ADP for 2011 through 2021¹
