

# Proposition 64 Public Health & Safety Grant Program Executive Steering Committee Seeking Membership

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is seeking members to serve on a new Executive Steering Committee (ESC) for the Proposition 64 Public Health & Safety Grant Program (Prop 64 PH&S Grant Program) for Cohort 3. Statements of Interest for this ESC membership will be taken until Friday, July 15, 2022 or until a full membership has been reached.

## Prop 64 PH&S Grant Program

In November 2016, Proposition 64 was passed by the voters of California. This Act, known as the Control, Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act, legalized the use of cannabis for those over the age of 21 and established laws to regulate the cultivation, distribution, sale, and use of cannabis.

Per [Revenue & Taxation Code, § 34019, subd. \(f\)\(3\)\(C\)](#), the BSCC will provide grant funds to local governments (defined as cities and/or counties) to assist with law enforcement, fire protection, or other local programs addressing public health and safety associated with the implementation of the Act.

## Considerations for potential Prop 64 PH&S Grant Program Cohort 3 ESC Membership

ESC members should reflect California's population and diverse racial, ethnic, geographic, gender, and cultural perspectives and backgrounds. There are important responsibilities and considerations that you must review before determining whether you can serve on this ESC, such as:

- Time commitment;
- Travel;
- Conflict of Interest Laws;
- Financial Reporting Requirements; and
- Ethics Training

Individuals interested in serving on the ESC should be prepared to attend several all-day meetings, the first of which is **July 27-28, 2022** to develop a Request for Proposals (RFP), then to read and rate proposals submitted for this grant program (this date TBD), and produce award recommendations for BSCC Board approval. \*Note: Prior experience on an ESC is not required.

Attach to the email a Word document (no more than one page) that contains your Statement of Interest. In the Statement of Interest, please address your professional expertise and/or life experiences, how your participation on this ESC will contribute to the development of this grant program, and assist the BSCC in meeting our diversity and subject matter expertise goals.

Once you have sent the email, you will receive an automatic reply acknowledging receipt of your submission to the BSCC. If you do not receive an automatic reply, please resubmit your request.
