1. What is the funding amount?

This Request for Offer (RFO) makes up to \$5000.00 available for each of the following locations:

- (1) one Large County – Northern¹ California
- (1) one Large County – Southern² California
- (1) one Medium County – Northern California
- (1) one Medium County – Southern California
- (1) one Small County
- (1) one contract specifically for outreach to federally recognized Native American tribes

2. Where do we submit the RFO?

Please submit your electronic RFO response to the Board of State and Community Corrections procurement inbox at procurement@bscc.ca.gov. Responses are due no later than Friday, March 19, 2021 at 5:00 pm.

3. Are there specific questions that need to be addressed for this RFO?

Applicants must provide a response to the prompts identified in Section E (RFO Response Content). In addition, please review the Scope of Work (Attachment A), Cost Worksheet (Attachment B), Bidder Declaration-GSPD 05-105, and DVBE Declaration Form-DGS PD 843 .

4. Is there a page limit to the RFO?

Yes, the Scope of Work (Attachment A) may not exceed two pages. The Cost Worksheet (Attachment B) does not include a page limit. Please reference Section E for additional information.
